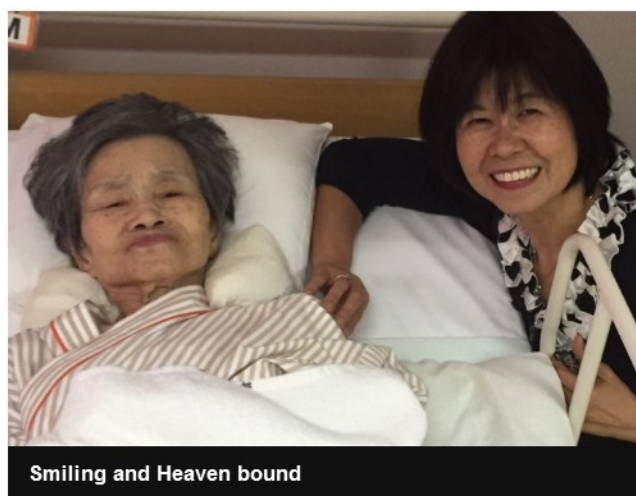
## Confirmation
